He knows what is in your heart even before you tell Him. As a priest once told us in a homily, *God knows what it's like to be in your skin! He made you, and knows you through and through, not just your body, but your mind, heart and soul...all of you!*

Another form of prayer I encourage is to pray the Rosary. Our Lady holds us close and she will intercede for us. *Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.*
