- <u>Leadership Development</u> How do we prepare parishioners to use their talents in their daily lives and parish ministries?

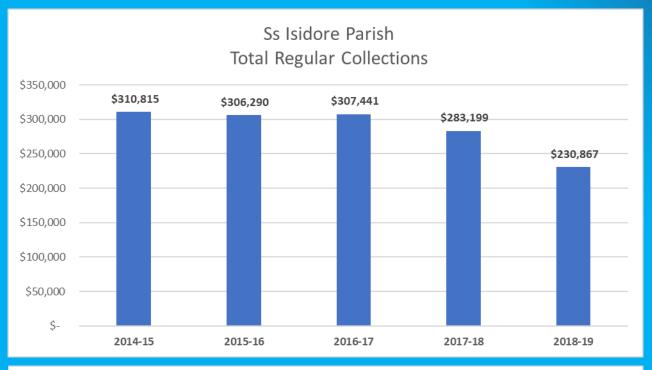

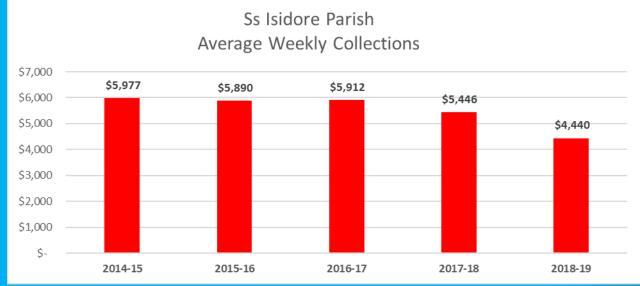

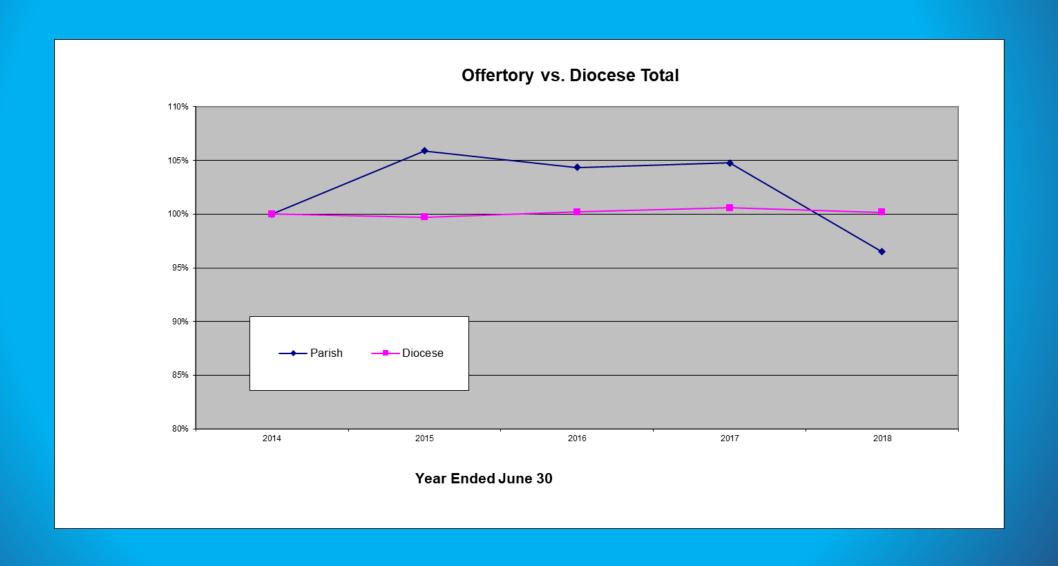
